



A Guide to School Life during the Covid 19 Pandemic

What your child may think will look like?		What will school actually look like?	
If I have a cold or feel unwell I can come to school	✘	If unwell you must stay at home	✓
My parent/carer can take me to my classroom or onto the playground	✘	Parents/Carers must drop at the school gate. Only staff and children are able to move around school.	✓
I can come early to school	✘	Children will arrive at their designated time - You will have been told this.	✓
I can go to Breakfast Club or After School Clubs	✘	These are not open.	✓
I can play with my friends before school	✘	You must line up with your adult outside the gate on Grantham Street. You must maintain social distancing.	✓
I will be in class with my teacher and class mates	✘	The school will be in bubbles of 10 and most teachers will be off site continuing with home learning. Children will most likely not be with their teacher	✓
I will be taught and have lessons like normal	✘	All children and staff must follow guidelines including safe distancing. School learning is the same as the Home Learning Programme	✓
I will be using different learning devices	✘	All children will use the same device each day and they will be issued with a small stationary pack.	✓
I can play on the playgrounds	✘	Your bubble will use the same area of the playground each day. You cannot go on to another section.	✓
I will be able to play basketball, hockey, cricket or football with my friends.	✘	Each bubble will have some sports equipment. You can only play with people in your bubble. Games where social distancing cannot be maintained will not be permitted.	✓
We will have assemblies or clubs	✘	No assemblies, clubs or mixing of bubbles is allowed.	✓
I can play with my friends at break times	✘	Class bubbles of 10 will have staggered break times. Bubble groups cannot mix.	✓
