

### Claremont Primary School Home School Agreement June 2020 - Extended school opening (COVID-19)

- *By sending my child to school during this period of extended opening, I adhere to the agreement below:*

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure that the same teachers and other staff are assigned to consistent groups on a weekly basis.</li> <li>• Arrange furniture and desks to maximize social distancing,</li> <li>• Remove any unnecessary items from the classroom such as: soft furnishings and other hard to clean items,</li> <li>• Minimise movement around school to maintain social distancing between groups,</li> <li>• Stagger start and finish times to minimise potential contact between groups,</li> <li>• Ensure that regular cleaning will take place at frequent intervals,</li> <li>• Highlight government advice on safe travel,</li> <li>• Provide a designated room for any child or adult displaying symptoms compatible with COVID-19.</li> <li>• Provide adequate soap and / or hand sanitiser to maintain high standards of cleanliness,</li> <li>• Make a prompt phone call to parents / carers of any child exhibiting symptoms compatible with COVID-19,</li> <li>• Take the recommended guidelines of isolating a group when a member of that group has displayed symptoms compatible with COVID-19,</li> <li>• Provide staff with appropriate PPE when administering care for a child with symptoms.</li> <li>• Continue to provide quality home-learning materials for all Claremont pupils.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure that children are in school every day and are dropped off and collected on time; or contact school if they will not be in.</li> <li>• Contact school if their child has symptoms consistent with COVID-19 and that the household will be following the rules regarding households self-isolating for 14 days.</li> <li>• Make sure that their child is brought to school at their bubbles' and year group's allocated time,</li> <li>• Ensure that they access the school grounds using the entry points allocated to your child's bubble and year group,</li> <li>• Support their child at 'drop-off' and if they are not calm and ready to enter school, take them home.</li> <li>• Make sure that only one parent / carer brings the child to school,</li> <li>• Maintain social distancing whilst dropping off and picking up their child from school including beyond the school gates.</li> <li>• Allow school to help their child wear a mask if they exhibit symptoms consistent with COVID-19.</li> <li>• Pick up their child promptly from school if they develop symptoms compatible with COVID-19, or if they need intimate care.</li> <li>• Keep their child at home if they behave in a way that endangers the safety of other children or adults such as: a failure to maintain reasonable social distancing, not following instructions and spitting.</li> <li>• Provide their child with a clean set of non-uniform clothing each day,</li> <li>• Ensure their child's clothes are suitable for outdoor learning and can be fastened by the child.</li> <li>• Will support their child with the home-learning provided by school.</li> <li>• Not send their child in with anything from home, apart from a coat and a lunchbox if they are not having school dinners.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Talk to an adult if they need help or have any questions about school.</li> <li>• Stay with the children in their group at playtimes and lunch times.</li> <li>• Wash their hands regularly and whenever instructed by an adult,</li> <li>• Maintain the social distancing principles promoted by school,</li> <li>• Look after their resources without sharing them with others,</li> <li>• Arrive at school in the correct place and line up as instructed,</li> <li>• Follow the new rules for the use of toilet,</li> <li>• Always maintain appropriate social distancing at playtime.</li> <li>• Not bring anything into school apart from a coat and their packed lunch.</li> </ul>
