## This week we are learning 18/06/18



### Literacy

Our book this week is Rosie's Walk

Ask your child to tell you about the story.

Who are the two characters in the story?

Where does Rosie go on the farm? What is the fox doing? What happens to the fox every time? Does the story have a happy or sad ending for Rosie? Why?

Your child has been taking part in guided reading – ask them what book they read this week.

### Letters and sounds

Some children are starting phase 5 letters and sounds this week

They are learning the **ie** sound as in tie, pie and quiet and the **ea** sound as in each, reach, pea

Some children are working on phase 4 letters and sounds

They are practising their reading and writing skills this week

Some children are recapping the phase 2 and 3 sounds for reading and writing.

Can you think of any words at home? Can you write them down?

Practise your reading and spellings every night for a few minutes and talk about the book.

### Maths

We are using positional language this week and also recapping 3D shapes. Using the pictures from Rosie's Walk, we are describing where Rosie and the fox are in the pictures. We are naming and describing 3D shapes, looking at the sides, faces and corners of the shapes.

Can you use a teddy or toy at home and put it in different positions? Can you use the 3D shape sheet we have sent home and practise naming and looking for the 3D shapes?

### Other

We are making tractor pictures out of lolly sticks

We are making Rosie puppets with positional language on them that you can use at home.

We are making a farm with animals and farm buildings. We are talking about which animals live on farms, which animals can be pets and which animals are wild.

Can you think of some farm animals, animals that are wild and animals that you can keep as pets? Make a list and bring it to school.
